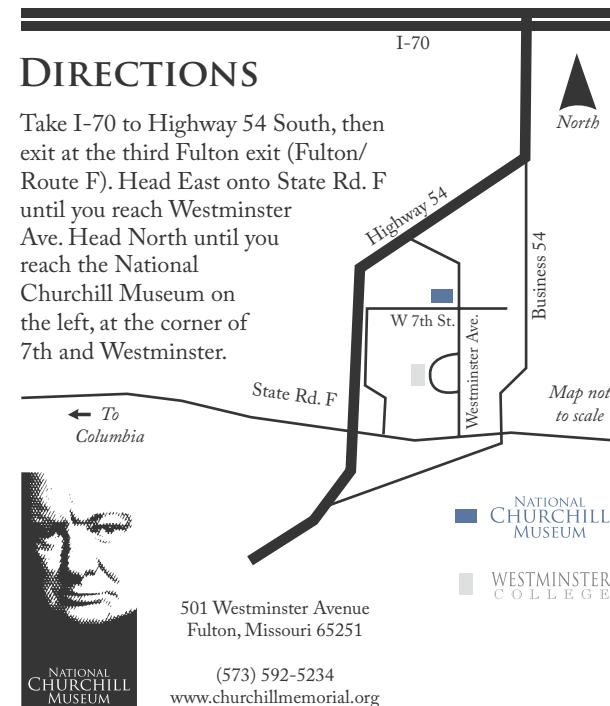

# Take your place beside the world leaders who followed in Churchill's footsteps at Westminster College.

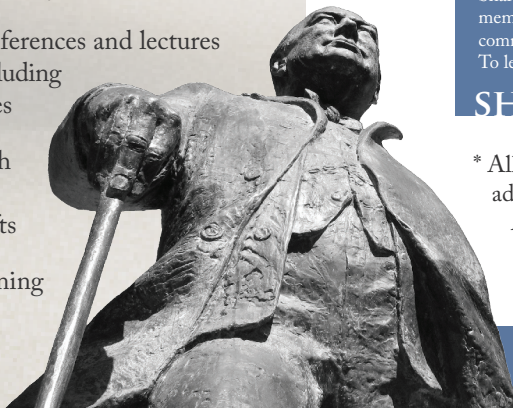
Enter the magnificent Christopher Wren-designed Church of St. Mary the Virgin, Aldermanbury, with its 17th century carvings and handcrafted organ... painstakingly moved from London to Fulton and lovingly reconstructed, stone-by-stone, on the Westminster campus as a tribute to Winston Churchill.

Walk through the sculpture "Breakthrough," created from eight sections of the actual Berlin Wall by celebrated artist Edwina Sandys, Churchill's granddaughter.
