
The Berlin Wall Sculpture – FOR TEACHERS

Across:

- 2 The sculpture consists of eight four-foot wide sections made of this material. **CONCRETE**
- 3 During the Cold War, US, France, and Britain joined and formed the Federal Republic of Germany, or _____ Germany, and they gave it a democratic government. **WEST**
- 4 Name of the Berlin Wall sculpture created by Edwina Sandys, granddaughter of Winston Churchill **BREAKTHROUGH**
- 6 The eight consecutive sections were originally located in this area, frequently visited by artists **BRANDENBURG GATES**

Down:

- 1 Month when 1) the Berlin Wall came tumbling down and 2) the dedication of the sculpture in Fulton **NOVEMBER**
- 5 The sculpture is made out of eight sections of this structure, originally meant to keep East Germans in and West Germans out. **BERLIN WALL**
- 7 The Soviet Union was afraid that they would be attacked and took their area and made it the German Democratic Republic or _____ Germany.

- 8 The translation for "unwahr", a phrase seen repeatedly on the sculpture **UNTRUTHS**
- 9 The name for images or lettering scratched, scrawled, painted or marked in any manner on property. **GRAFFITI**
